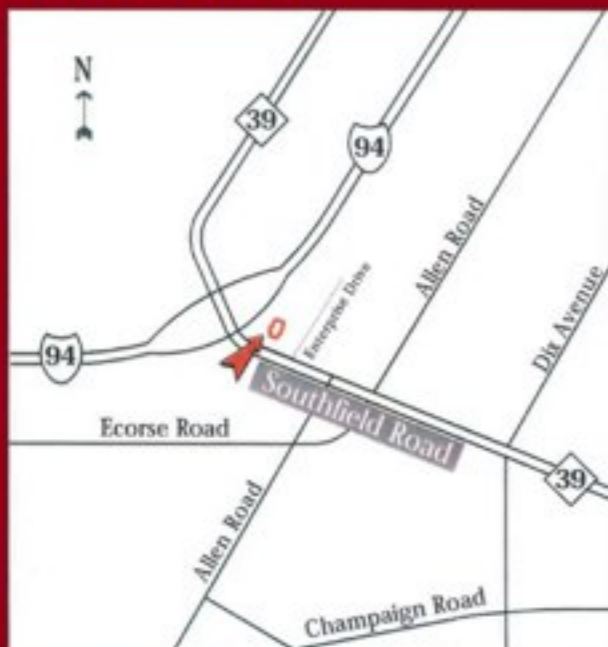


LOCATION MAP
